C) Water availability, management, and infrastructure on the property

The free Microsoft program, "Snipping Tool" is a helpful way to make a selection to copy a map to this form.

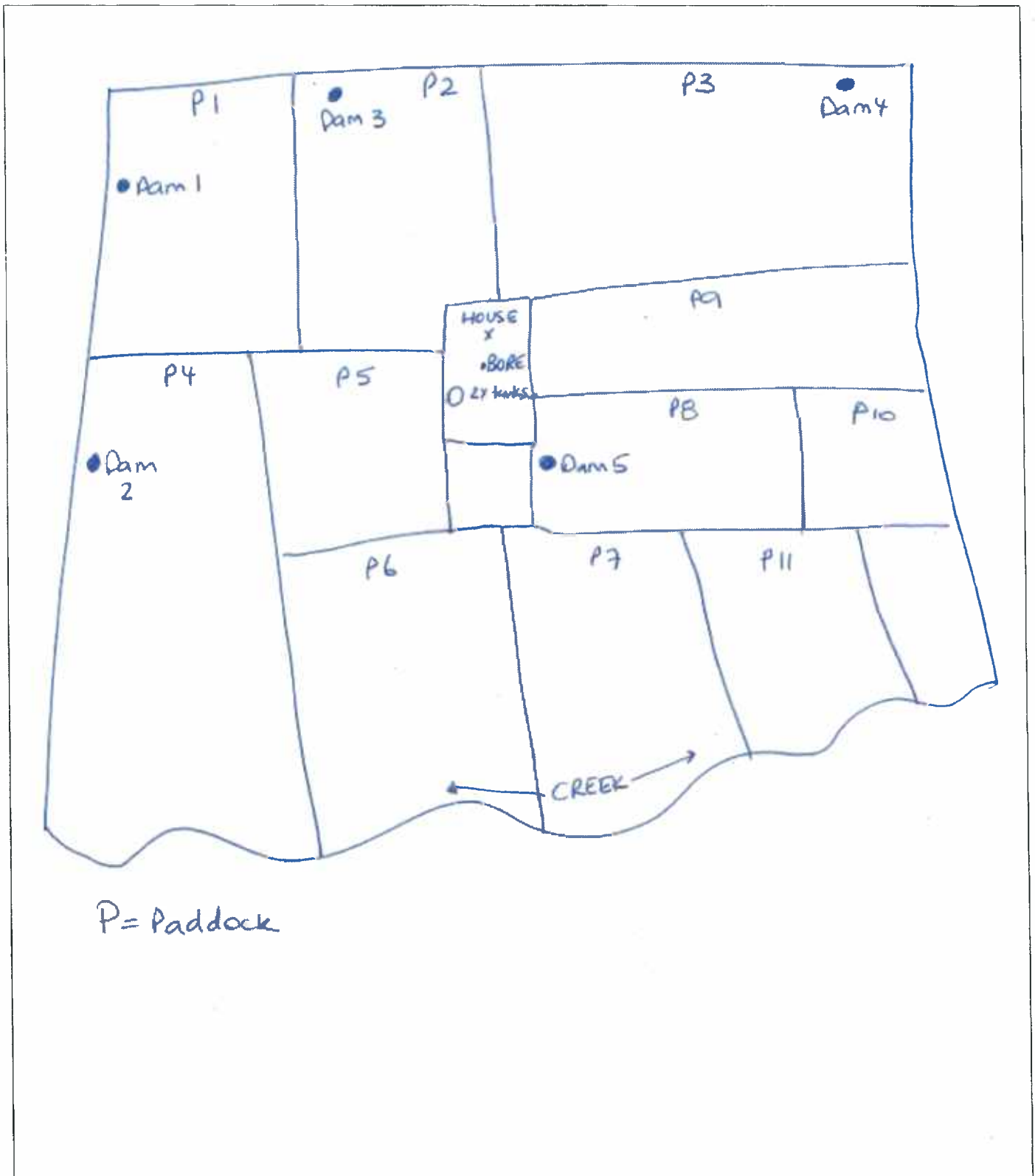
